The constant aim and purpose of the Moseley General Lodge of Instruction has always been to supplement and support the work of Private Lodges in their rehearsal and instructional endeavours, by providing an informal and convivial atmosphere, to ensure every aspect of the ritual work of all the Lodge Offices can be both practised and discussed in their wider context.

We believe frequent attendance brings the most benefits, though this is not a requirement. It is NOT our intention to supplant the work of private Lodges; participants are expected to support fully the work of their own Private Lodges of Instruction and Rehearsal.

Whilst this Mission Statement remains unchanged it is time for an adjustment in approach.

a) Entered Apprentices and Craftsmen will, in future, be restricted to those nights designated for the work for which they are qualified. These dates can be ascertained from the Preceptor.

b) Participation in the M.G.L.of.I. Festival will be open to any Mason (not Masters or Past Masters) who volunteers and proves their capability to fill an Office above the one which he occupies in any Lodge. Previous non-attendance will NOT be a bar to participation, though attendance at the nominated Festival Rehearsals will be mandatory.
